135+ Years of Serving Springfield Youth: Founded in 1891, the Springfield Boys & Girls Club has provided generations of Club Kids with a safe place to learn, grow, build meaningful relationships, and create brighter futures.

More Than 600 Club Kids Served Annually: The Club provides high-quality out-of-school-time programming for more than 600 registered members ages 6–18, including after-school, summer, and youth development programs that support academic success, leadership development, and personal growth.

Creating Opportunity Beyond the School Day: The Club was open for more than 1,100 hours after school and on weekends in 2025, providing youth with consistent access to safe spaces, caring mentors, academic support, and enrichment opportunities during critical out-of-school hours.

A Safe Place for Youth After School & Beyond: Through structured programming, mentorship, and enrichment activities, the Club provides a supportive environment where youth can develop confidence, explore new interests, and build skills for the future.

Serving Springfield's Community: Beyond our registered members, the Springfield Boys & Girls Club serves hundreds of additional youth and families through community outreach, special events, and programs hosted on our campus.

Investing in Youth: In 2025, the Springfield Boys & Girls Club invested 61 cents of every dollar spent directly into programs serving youth, ensuring resources are focused on meaningful experiences and opportunities for Club Kids.

A 60,000+ Square Foot Youth Facility: Located at 481 Carew Street, the Club's facility includes a swimming pool, two gyms, education spaces, two art rooms, a teen lounge, computer resources, a game room, and outdoor recreation areas featuring a new pavilion for outdoor learning, sports courts, and two baseball fields.

Programs That Support the Whole Child: Club programming focuses on five key areas of youth development: Education & Career Development, Character & Leadership, Health & Life Skills, Sports & Recreation, and the Arts.
